One of the largest annual charitable events to help underserved and vulnerable children is Give Kids A Smile® (GKAS), a year-round access to oral healthcare program. Oral health professionals from across the country provide oral health education, screenings and treatment to children. In 2020, the Indian Health Service entered into an agreement with the American Dental Association (ADA) to work together to improve the oral health of American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) children through the GKAS program. Most IHS, Tribal, and urban dental programs provided services during special 1-2 day GKAS events. This infographic summarizes the first three years of this collaboration.

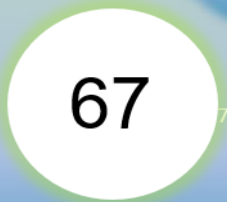

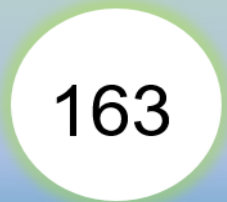
