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1. List any new members or subcommittee members: Beth Wyatt may join in 2018 to take Brad Whistler's place as a 1609-funded state.
  2. Describe the purpose of your committee: The purpose of the workgroup is to provide guidance to ASTDD's Chronic Disease Integration Consultant about member needs related to oral health and chronic disease integration and collaboration opportunities and to assist with the development and review of tools and resources for ASTDD and NACDD members on the relationship between oral health and chronic diseases. The workgroup is also charged with providing suggestions regarding opportunities for ASTDD to provide technical assistance to state oral health programs on oral health and chronic diseases.
  3. List your recent committee accomplishments: Convened 4 meetings of the WG in 2017. In collaboration with the workgroup, developed the following items: Logic model and workplan; Chronic Disease Domain Framework one-pager outlining how oral health fits into the 4 chronic disease domains; identified state success story candidates; drafted a tip sheet on state CD program and SOHP collaboration; provided feedback and consultation to the University of Iowa PRC regarding a survey they wanted to field with state oral health and chronic disease program directors; represented NACDD at the National Oral Health Conference in April 2017 and participated in the ASTDD member roundtables to promote oral health/chronic disease collaboration activities; served as a liaison to NACDD and CDC's Chronic Disease Center/Division on Oral Health and worked with NACDD consultants to link them to ASTDD consultants/committees; identified opportunities for oral health to participate in chronic disease communications to NACDD members; provided technical assistance to the six CDC-funded 1609-pilot states; attended monthly ASTDD consultant calls; conducted a joint General Member Webinar with NACDD in October, 2017 that was moderated by Lynn Bethel and featured speakers from three oral health programs (TN, VT and Chicago Public Schools) to showcase how oral health has successfully been integrated into the WSCC model; participated in a CDC-reverse site visit with ASTDD leadership in November, 2017; collaborated with ASTDD consultants to develop a draft outline for white paper of oral health and chronic diseases; participated on several conference calls with the American

Dental Association and NACDD's Associate Director for Partnership Development to discuss opportunities for oral health/chronic disease collaboration at the national level; and developed and submitted a poster on ASTDD and NACDD's collaborative partnership that will be presented at the NACDD Showcase in February 2018.

4. Describe your current committee activity: The workgroup is providing input/recommendations for the white paper that is under development on oral health and chronic disease integration. The ASTDD Chronic Disease Consultant is also providing technical assistance to the University of Iowa PRC on the development of a report on this topic that will be finalized in June 2018.

5. Describe the future activities planned by your committee: In 2018, the workgroup will be providing input into the proposed revisions to ASTDD's website on oral health/chronic disease. They will also help with developing questions for the ASTDD member sharing session at the NOHC that will feature states that are implementing joint oral health/chronic disease programs/interventions and reviewing the white paper that is under development.

6. Describe any subcommittees your committee uses, their roles and activities: We may be assembling a subcommittee to help with the development of the white paper.
