2. Describe the purpose of your committee:
The committee oversees all the activities of the Association regarding the National Oral Health Surveillance System, BRFSS, YRBS, PRAMS, the Synopses of State Dental Public Health Programs, and BSS training and technical assistance. A coordinator and various advisory groups work with committee members to accomplish all objectives. The coordinator and an additional consultant provide technical assistance and training to states on oral health assessment and surveillance. The Data Committee also assists other ASTDD Committees with their data collection activities.
3. List your recent committee accomplishments:
 - The committee completed the 20201 Synopses report, updated the 2022 Synopses questionnaire including the online submission process, in preparation for the OMB submission, updated the list of state added BRFSS/PRAMS questions, updated the oral health surveillance data resource guide, reviewed drafts of the national oral health data portal, and updated the committee's logic model and workplan.
 - Data Committee consultants (Kathy Phipps and Mike Manz) provided technical assistance on oral health surveillance issues to the following states/territories: Alabama, Arizona, Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Montana, New Hampshire, New Jersey, North Dakota, Pennsylvania, and Vermont.
 - Kathy Phipps completed an analysis and report using data from the environmental scan of COHSII states.
 - The children's BSS manual was approved by the OMB and Kathy Phipps is in the process of formatting the manual for publication in January 2022.
 - Kathy Phipps completed the narrative portion of the data dissemination BPAR.
