## **ACTIVITIES**

- 1. Maintain/add to list of current or archived ASTDD policy statements, issue briefs, white papers, and other resource documents, with cross referencing as appropriate.
- 2. Continue to identify links and dental public health policy and resource documents for ASTDD website.
- Develop relationships with partners to broaden data and dissemination of dental public health policy statements, white papers and other resource documents.
- 4. As needed/practical, guery or conduct assessment of ASTDD members (or subset, e.g., BOD) on dental public health resources priorities & develop dental public health resource documents workplan.
- 5. Create/collaborate on new dental public health policy statements, issue briefs and other resource documents.
- 6. Communicate dental public health policy statements, issue briefs and resource documents to members.
- 7. Collaborate with partners to identify dental public health training opportunities and resources.
- Identify and alert members to dental public health advocacy opportunities.
- 9. Identify and alert members to opportunities for educating policymakers at the state/territorial level
- 10. Propose dental public health resources agenda to Board of Directors
- 11. Collaborate with partners to address and comment on federal, state and organizational oral health policy issues.

- 6. Members & partners notified of new dental public health resources by email, website, or other method(s) e.g., via other electronic channels and social media.
- 7. Dental public health training opportunities identified and members notified.
- 8. Opportunities for educating policymakers identified and action alerts posted.
- Public health resources leadership opportunities promoted.
- 10. As appropriate, dental public health resources agenda proposed to Board of Directors.
