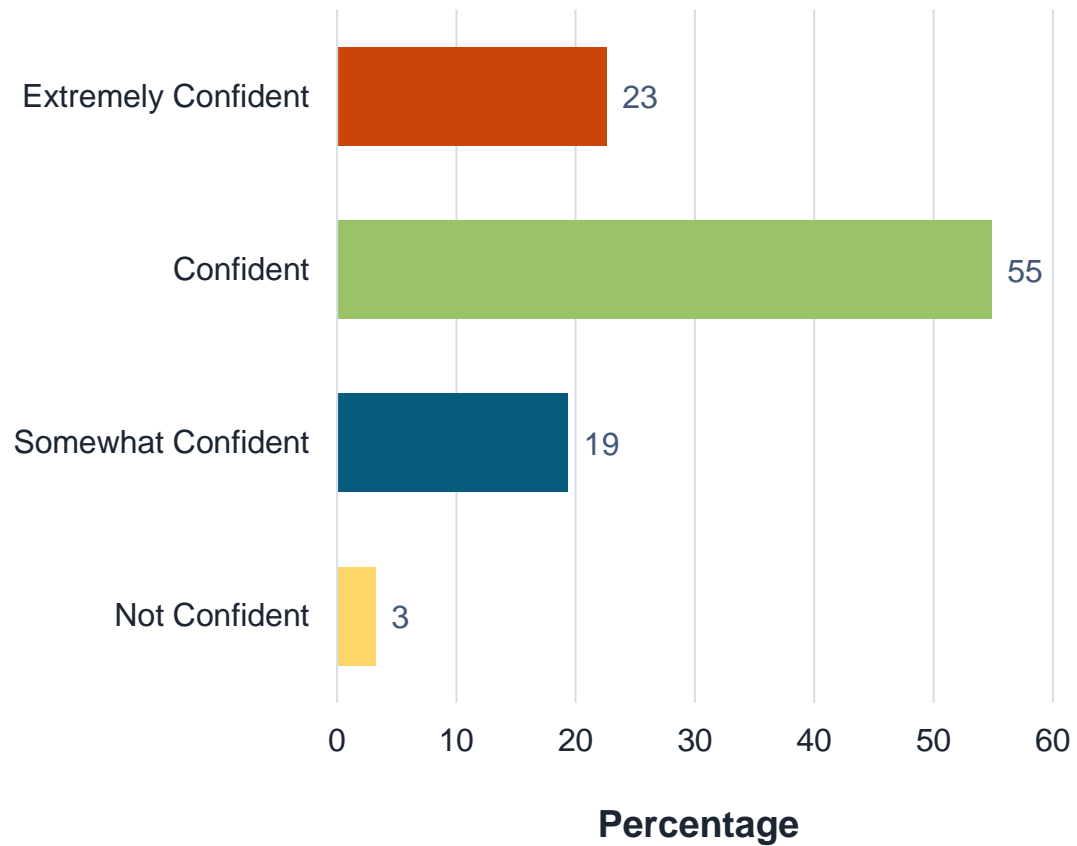

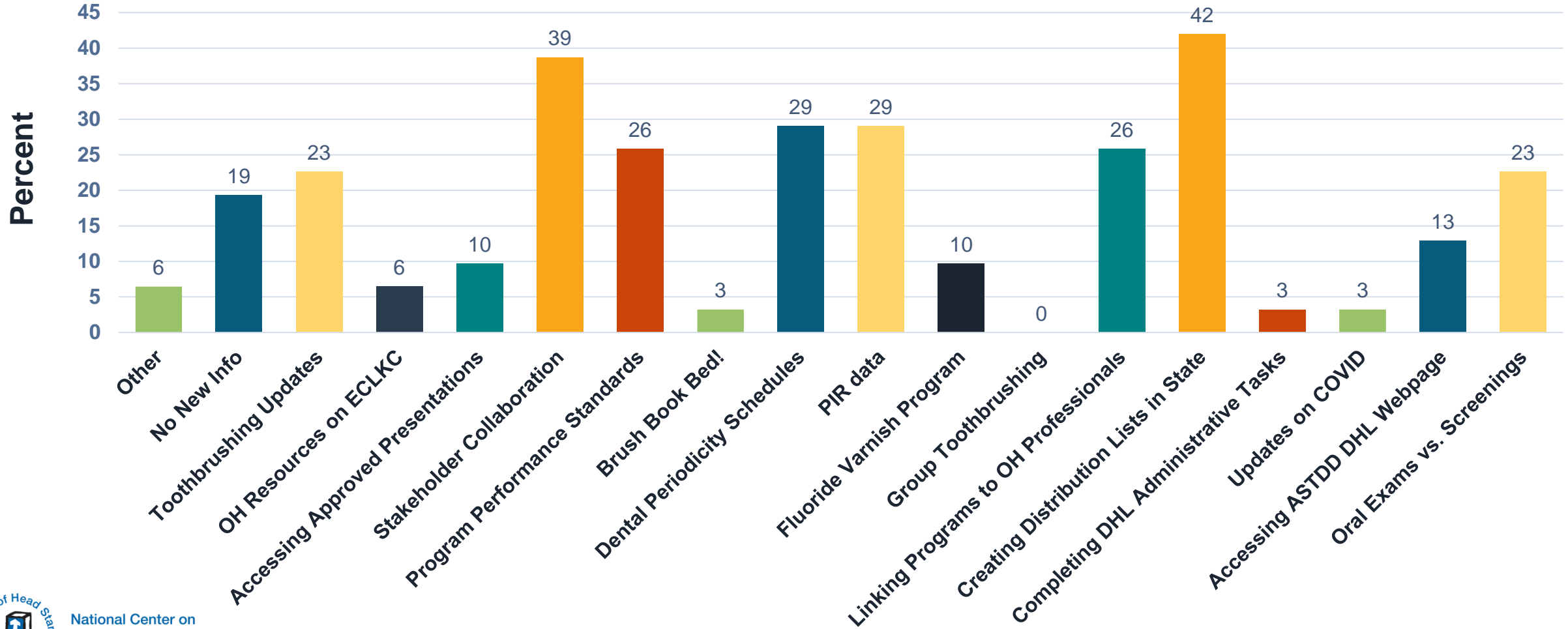
Q3. Confidence in Role as a DHL

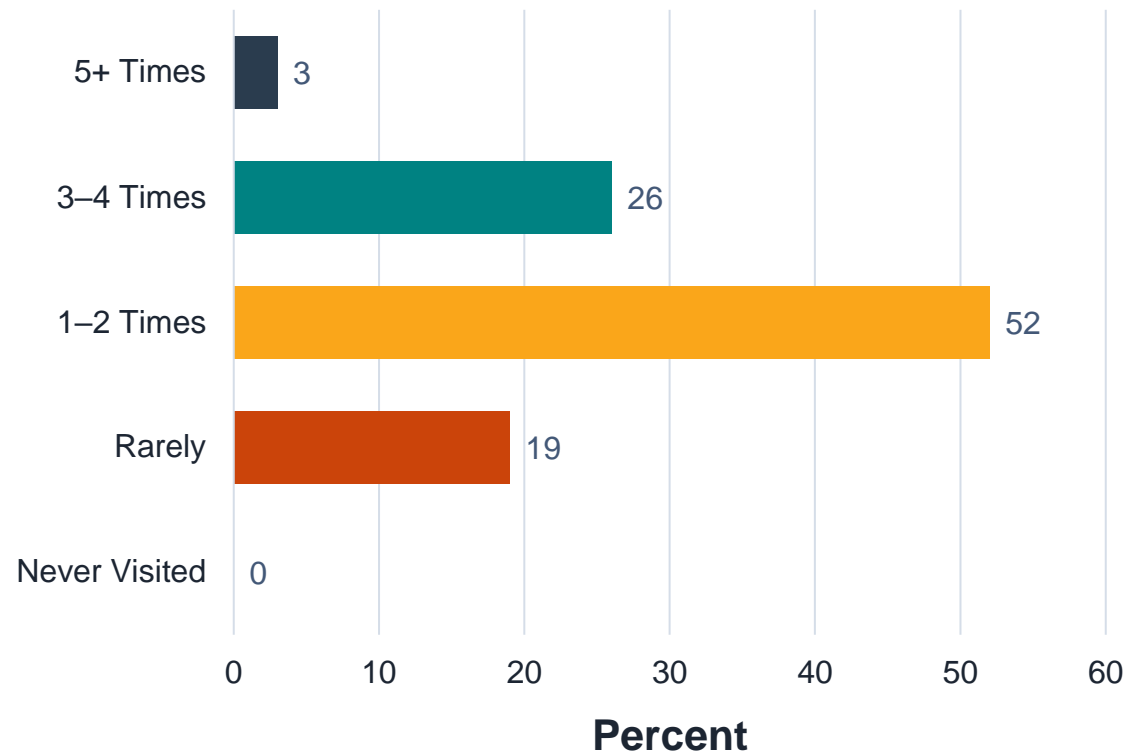

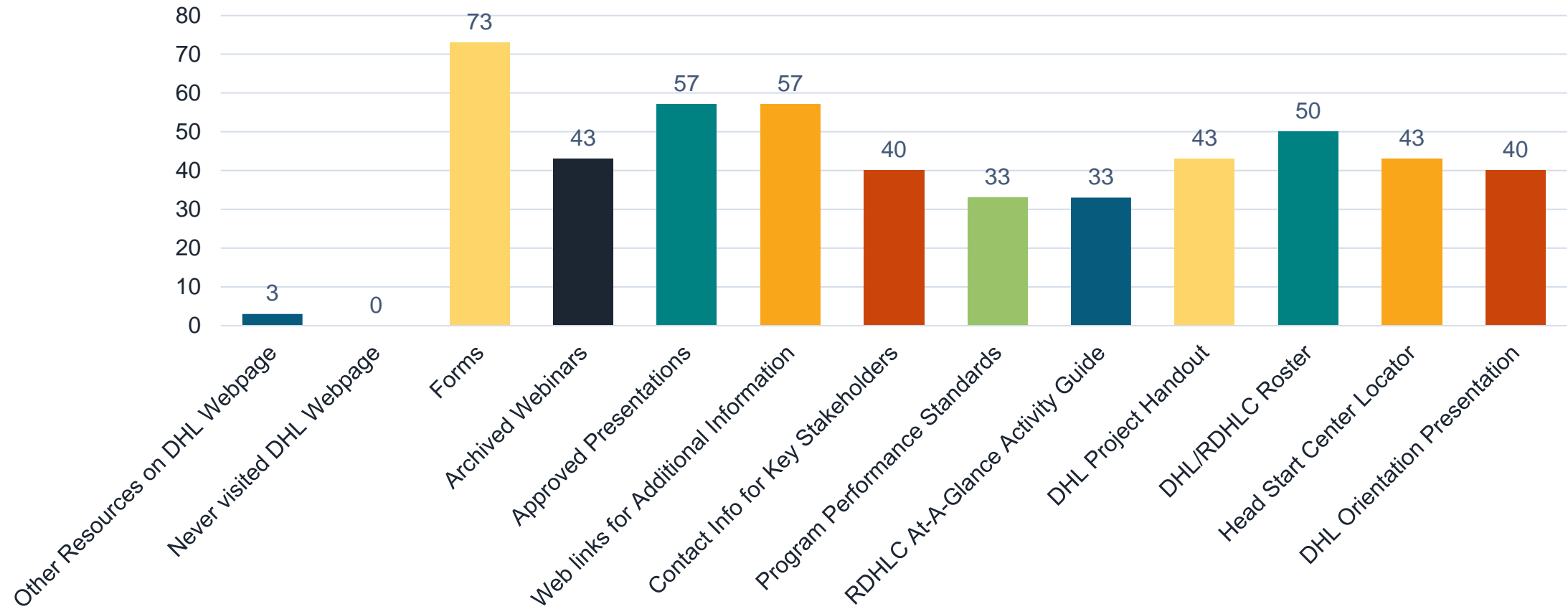
Q7. Times Per Month Used ASTDD DHL Webpage

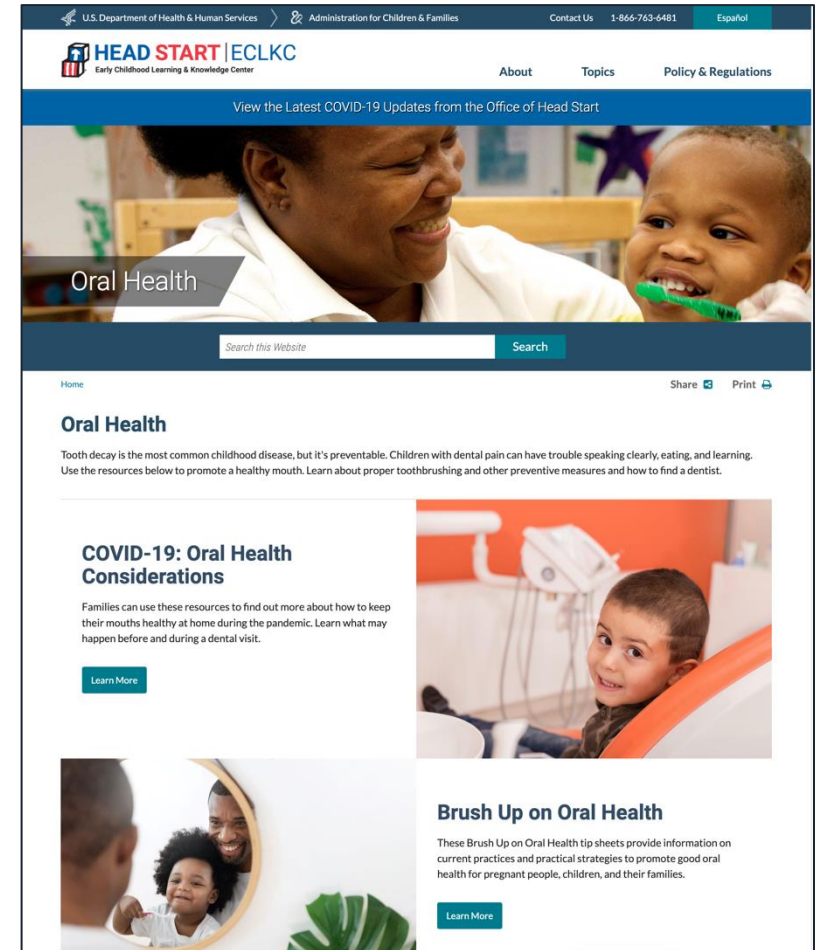
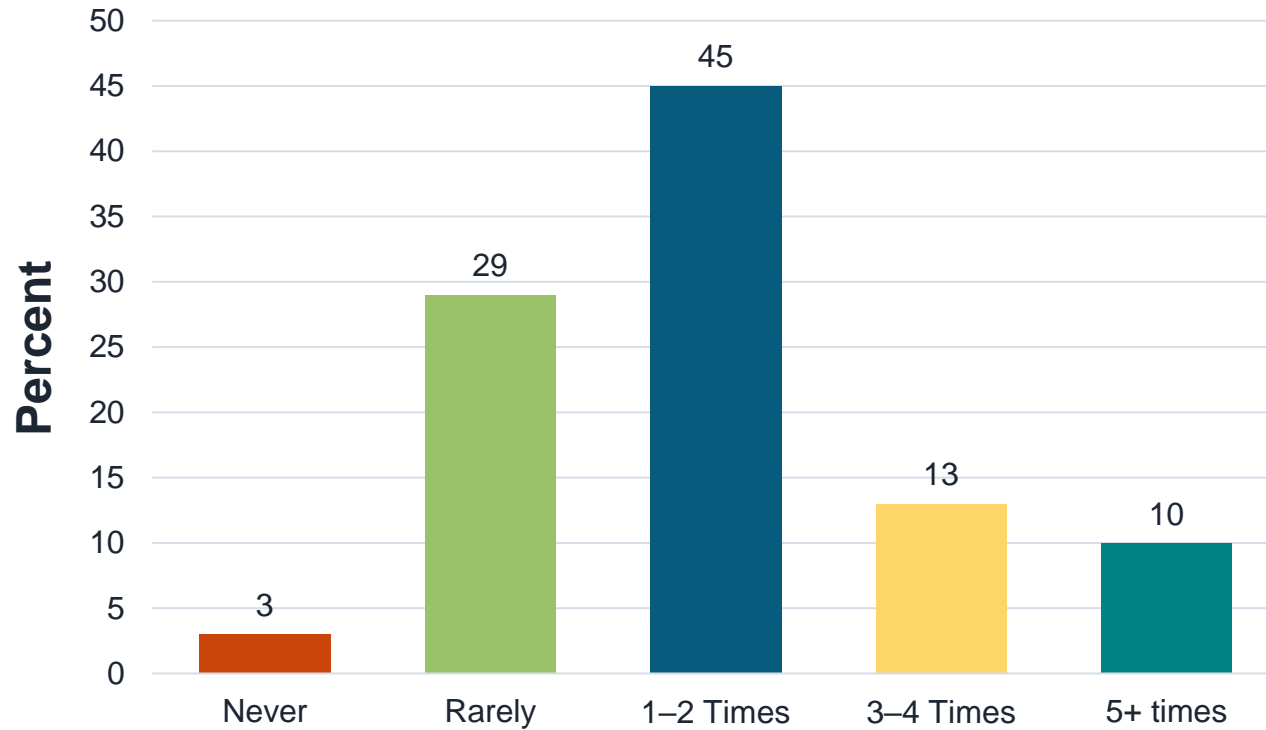
Q8. Information Used on DHL Webpage in the Past Year

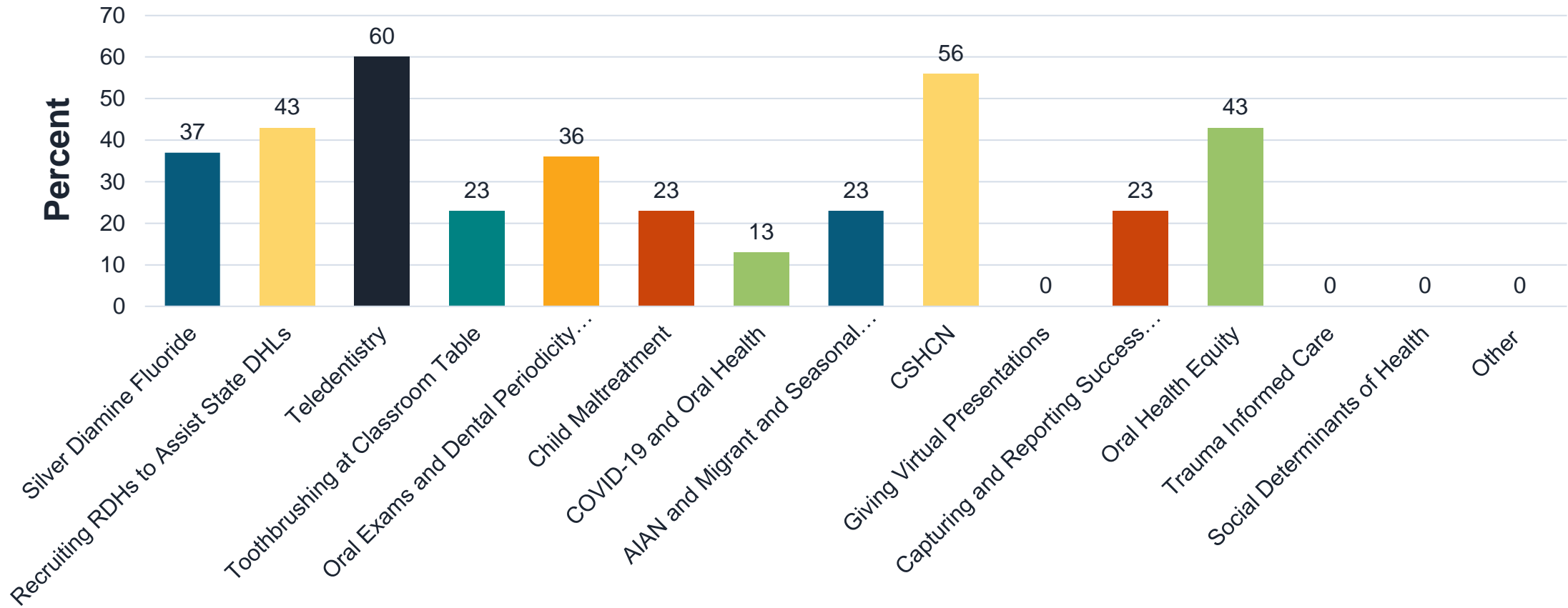
Q9. Times per Month Used ECKLC for Information and Resources

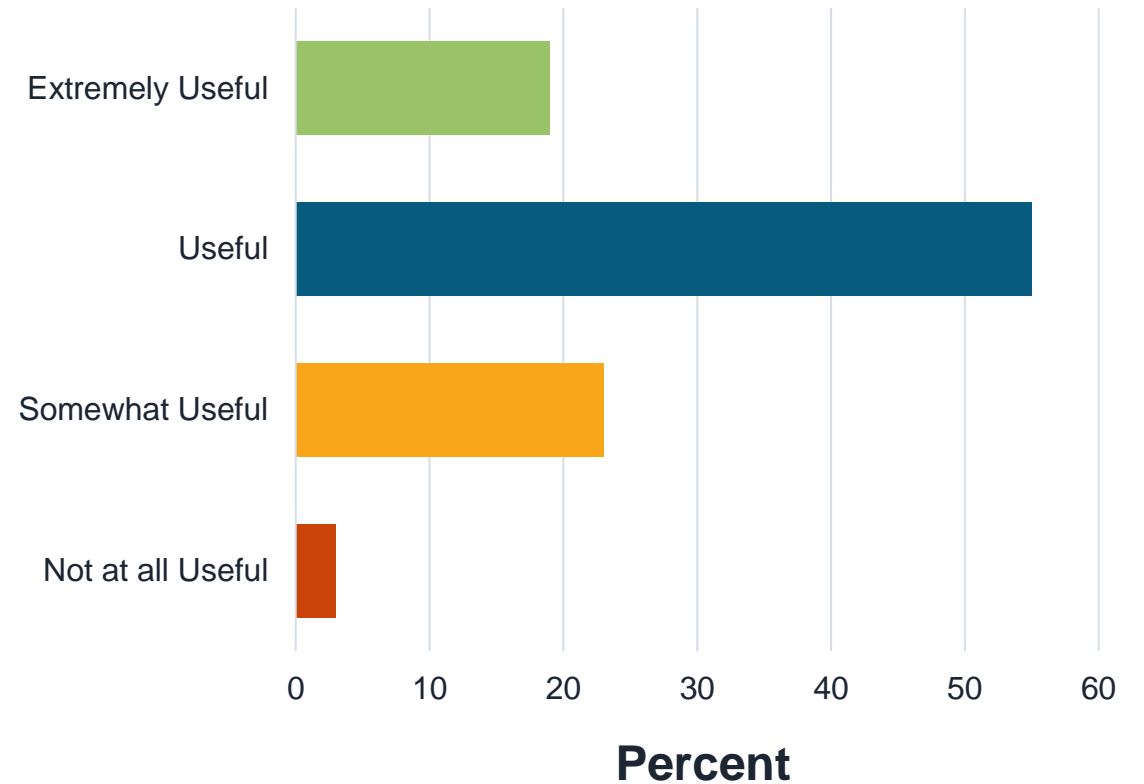

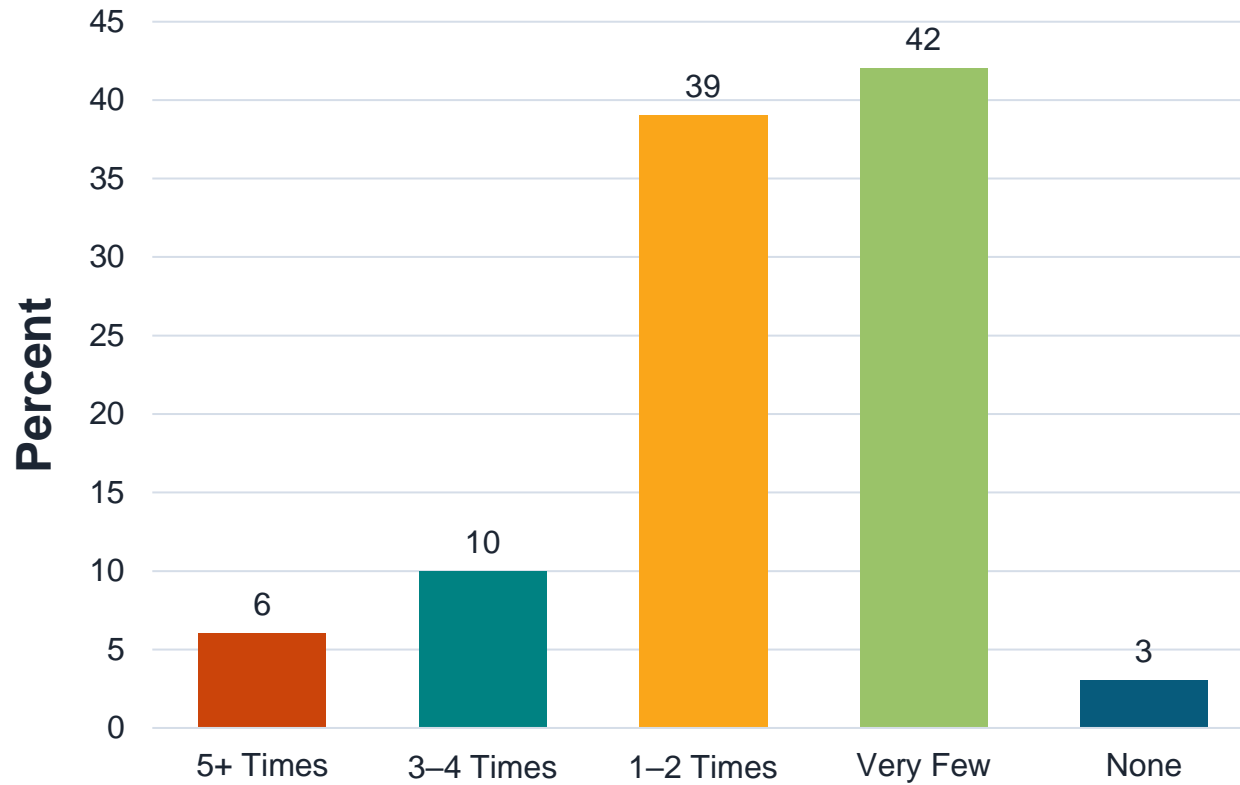

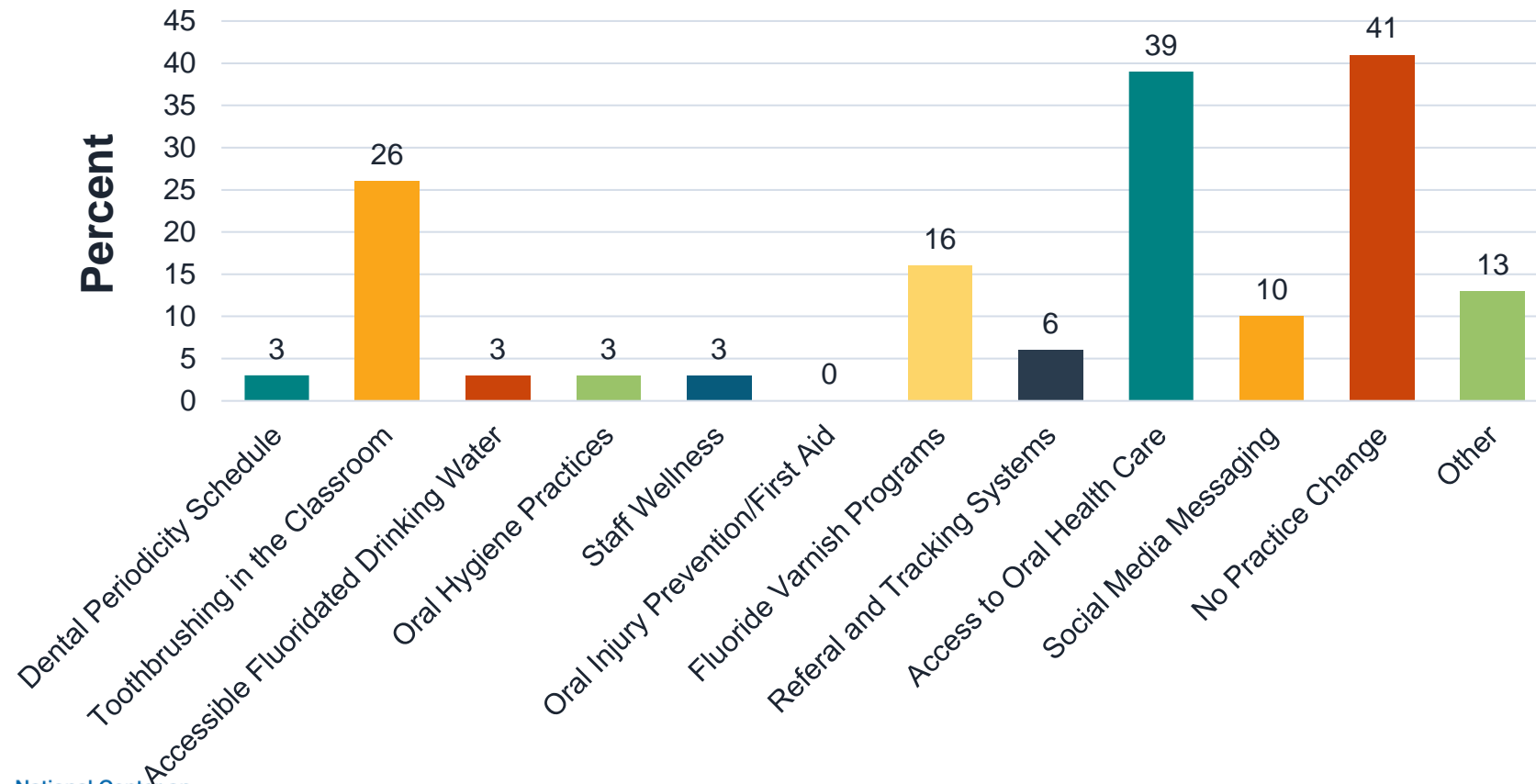
Q13. DHL-Related Requests Per Quarter

Q16. How Head Start Programs are Using *Resources to Make You Smile!*

Using Information

- Programs include information in their media outlets
 - Newsletters
 - Websites
- Share newsletter with program staff, health managers, and state collaboration officers
- Share topic-specific information with individual parents

Using Recipes

- Include recipes in programs' snack schedules
- Use recipe testing at the program to provide a connection to parents
- Staff share stories of how their children at home like or dislike a recipe





DHL Annual Assessment Findings

Q21. Most significant challenges faced in fulfilling role as a DHL

Theme	Key Challenges
Provide services; lack of time, funding; geography; travel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enough time to participate in meetings and connect with partners across the state • Travel to multiple centers and recruiting volunteers for events • More time to dedicate to the DHL project
Establish and maintain contacts; staff and stakeholder turnover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keeping up with recent and frequent staff turnover • Making connections with Head Start programs and groups in the state • Maintaining accurate and up-to-date lists of Head Start centers and health managers
Limited access to care	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Finding oral health professionals willing to see children with unmet need and who covered by Medicaid • Navigating how to help programs meet their children's oral health needs • Understanding how PIR data can be used to improve access to care
COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unable to work with Head Start programs for the past 2 years because of COVID • Pandemic worries persist • COVID-created challenges including limited enrollment and staff shortages
Additional Comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Schedule conflicts with Health Services Advisory Committee Meeting dates • Steep learning curve
